### Abstract:

Karl Baumgartner's path to Fort Bend County was truly unique. His great grandfather emigrated to America from Switzerland in the mid-1800's to escape persecution for his Mennonite religious beliefs, and settled in Kansas. Karl's paternal grandfather, although a Kansas farm boy, earned a doctorate degree at the University of Chicago. Karl's parents were widely acclaimed professors of ornithology at Oklahoma State University. Although they taught in an urban setting, they raised their children in a rural location outside of Stillwater and Karl developed a formative attachment to nature conservancy, ecological preservation, and rural life.

Karl is a graduate of Colgate University in upstate New York. He played college football, an importance influence, and worked on Wall Street early in his career. His real ambition was to work for himself, so leveraging his business experience, he chose to start a mobile home manufacturing dealership in 1973 in Rosenberg, Texas at a location he felt had good potential. He hit the bull's eye.

Karl describes building his business, watching Rosenberg and Fort Bend County grow over the years, and enjoying local outdoor recreation. Seabourne Creek Nature Park is a prime example of the confluence of Karl's life-long interests. His story is another example of the diversity among Fort Bend County's residents.
