Abstract: Stephen Arthur Doggett 10/21/2021

Stephen Doggett was born in Richmond, and as he says in this interview, he has lived there his entire life, except for the years when he earned his undergraduate and law degrees. He describes life in Richmond during the 1950s and '60s, when it was much smaller and offered children like him lots of freedom. His father died at a young age, so Stephen worked in his mother's flower shop, which broadened his experiences even further.

He says he chose a law career without really knowing what lawyers do. As a consequence, his work in the local legal system led him into varied opportunities, especially when working as a court-appointed defense attorney. Over the years he has dealt with many well-known local attorneys and even a couple of legendary defense attorneys like Percy Foreman and Joe Jamail.

Anyone interested in learning more about the Fort Bend County legal scene and its history will enjoy his interview.
